REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
2016 Elders Firewood Project

The Native Village of Eyak (Tribe) is soliciting proposals for 2016 Elders Firewood Project. **Proposals must be received by the Native Village of Eyak at the main office 110 Nicholoff Way, Cordova Alaska by 4 P.M. local time on Friday, October 21, 2016.**

Proposals must be marked Attn: Jackie Ladd or Kerin Kramer, 2016 Elder Firewood Bid. Include name, contact information and amount of bid. Proposals may be hand delivered to the main office, emailed to Kerin Kramer, kerin.kramer@eyak-nsn.gov or mailed to Native Village of Eyak, P.O. box 1388 Cordova, AK 99574.

The project generally consists of, but is not necessarily limited to, the following major items: Providing firewood to thirteen NVE Elders. Cutting, Splitting and Delivering 1 cord of firewood to each Elders home. The Contractor should take into consideration the following;

- Coordinating with Elder Services, Jackie Ladd to receive the proxy personal use timber permit for each Elder. (NVE will be responsible for cost of permit)
- Shall comply with all State of Alaska Division of Forestry stipulations for use of timber permit.
- Completing the job within two weeks after the award of bid.
- Contact Elder with time of wood delivery
- Cut wood to no more than 14" in length
- Split into manageable size for Elders to haul
- Will need to supply all equipment to complete firewood project
