- Performs expediting, moving and other duties.
- Collect and weigh fish, issue accurate fish tickets to delivery vessels.
- Cook as needed.
- Assist with fuel transfers and sales as needed.
- Performs additional related duties as assigned.

Competencies (Knowledge, Skills and Abilities)

Must have the ability to take direction from Supervisor and work in a team environment. Knowledge of mechanical systems, basic carpentry skills and ability to prioritize work. Ability to work in a small space with other crew members for days at a time. Knowledge of mariner's knots. Knowledge of boat operation and maintenance. Valid drivers' license.

Experience Requirement

Experience working on and around boats, basic mechanic boats. Experience in boat operation.

Performance Standard

Applicant must be able to regularly lift and carry up to 75 lbs.. The position requires that applicants are in sufficient condition to perform physically demanding tasks. The use of hand, eye and muscle coordination to safely operate boats, power tools and hand tools is required.

Environmental Factors

Work will be completed out of doors. Some tasks may pose a significant risk of encountering inclement/cold weather and dangerous wildlife. Some possibility of remote/cold water survival
