Responsibilities/Duties

Competencies (Knowledge, Skills and Abilities)

Must be a hard worker and have the ability to be self-motivated and work together. Must have knowledge of basic power tool operation and ability to complete work safely and efficiently using power and hand tools. Willingness to participate in and comply with safety programs.

Experience Requirement

Must be minimum 18 years of age. Will be subject to drug and alcohol screening as per NVE policies.

Education Requirement

High school diploma, equivalent or enrolled in secondary school.

Performance Standard

Applicant must be able to regularly lift and carry 50 lbs. The position requires that applicants are in sufficient condition to perform physically demanding tasks. The use of hand, eye and muscle coordination to safely operate power tools and hand tools is required.

Environmental Factors

Majority of work will be completed out of doors. This position entails risks of injury from using power tools and normal risks of physical labor done in the outdoors.
